Arnold HEUMAKERS (1950) studied history at the University of Amsterdam. He teaches at this same university in the department of General Cultural Studies. At the same time he is active as a literary critic for the Dutch newspaper NRC Handelsblad and in his own right as an essayist. He has published many articles and essays on literature, history and philosophy. And he has publishes several books, mostly collections of essays, all written in Dutch. Some titles : Onleefbare waarbeden (1990), Schoten in de concertzaal (1993), Lessen in levenslust. Over Casanova (1993), De fatale cirkel (1997), De horizon van Buitenveldert (1997), De schaduw van de Vooruitgang (2003). A study on the aesthetic revolution of the 18th century is in preparation.
